

## Creating your account on Filene's Web Site using NASCUS's group access code option.

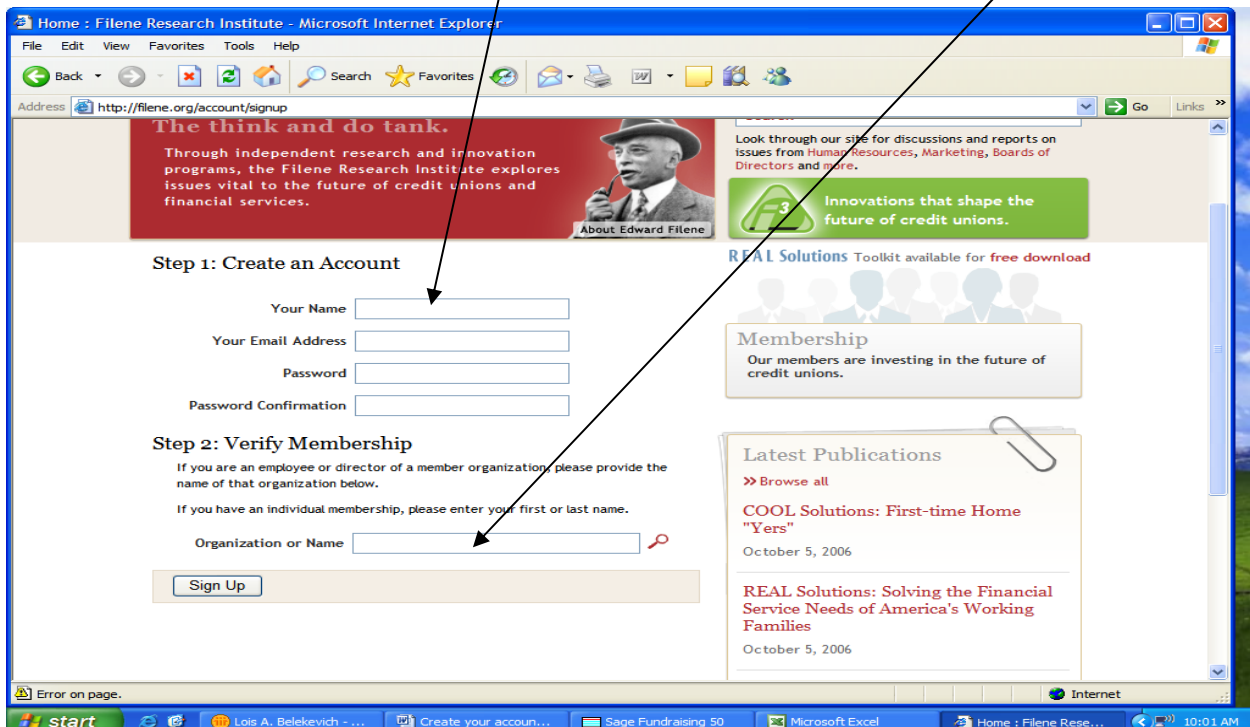
From Filene's home page ([www.filene.org](http://www.filene.org))...

Type in your information, and select your password.

Verify your organization's membership by selecting it in the drop down list (NASCUS) Click Sign Up.



## NASCUS Group Access Activation


Below is a screen shot of the Web Site once you've completed the initial information and selected your organization. You will be notified that your email does not match the domain of the member organization NASCUS (nascus.org) and provides 3 options. Go to **Option 2: Enter the access code for your organization.**

In the Access Code box please type: 99NASC

Hit the **Sign Up** button. This will bypass the email system verification process and will allow your account to be activated.
